

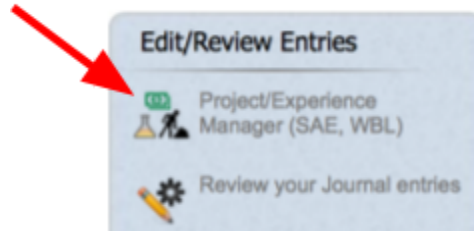
AET - Project Plan Guide

STEP 1: ADD your project into AET

1) Click on Project Manager in **JOURNAL**

2) NAME: Examples

4) Tracking Your Experience:

- a) **Entrepreneurship:** YOU OWN YOUR PROJECT, YOU PUT MONEY INTO IT, YOU PLAN TO SELL YOUR PROJECT
- b) **Placement - PAID:** You work for a company or individual and receive a payment in return for your hours or services worked
- c) **Placement - UNPAID:** You work volunteer hours, or have an internship that is unpaid working for a company or individual.
- d) **Agriscience:** ONLY for agriscience projects
